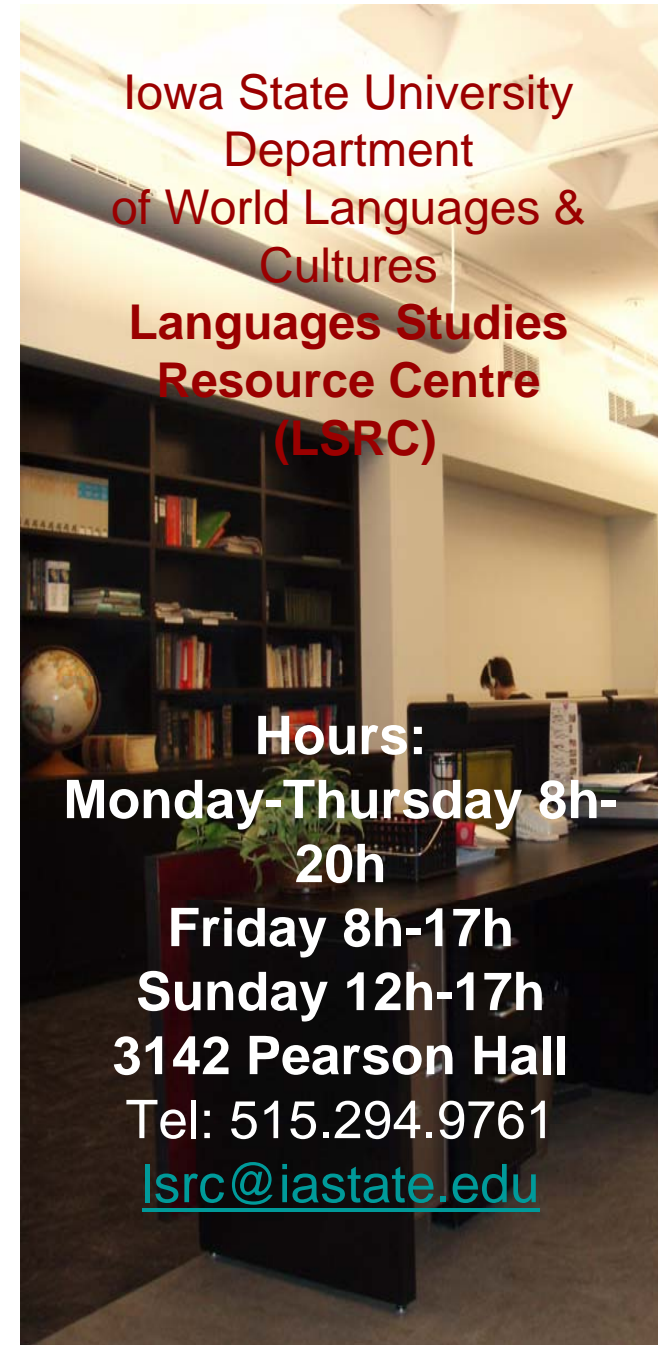
- Listen to language audio materials via computer or IPOD available in the media section

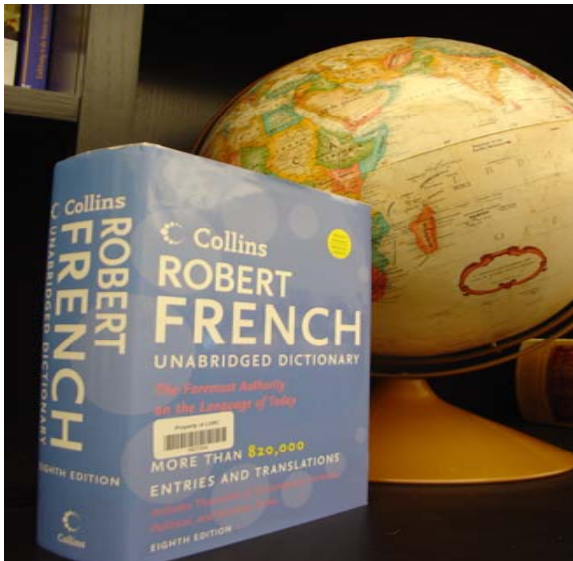

The Language Studies Resource Centre for French Students

The primary mission of the LSRC is to improve the quality of classroom learning by providing language resources to students. Specifically to French students the centre offers a wide variety of French film/DVD titles as well as French language television programming via satellite. Students also have access to a variety of writing aids such as French language spell checking and reference materials, such as French/English, English/French, and French dictionaries, visual dictionaries etc.



Not only does the centre offer resources such as books, films, foreign language television, but it also aims to provide students with a comfortable space to study, socialize and enjoy learning and conversing in a casual and comfortable environment. The centre also offers students access to a small conference room with teleconferencing capabilities as well as a computer lab. In the future, the LSRC aims to provide more online services for students such as online foreign language television channels.
